## Procedures on arrival into school and at the end of the day.

Pupils are expected to arrive at school from 8:40 am and will wait on the playground until the whistle goes. Pupils then line up in front of their new class teachers, who will have a sign showing each classes name. Children from years 1-6 will be collected from the Junior Playground (old infant playground). Once the whistle goes can parents from Years 1-6 please stand back from the line? This is so that we don't have congestion near entrances.

Nursery and Reception pupils will wait in their Early Years playground and teachers will take them in via the classroom door.



At the end of the school day children from Years 3-6 will be taken down to the playground and dismissed by the Class Teacher. Pupils in Nursery, Reception and Years 1 and 2 will be dismissed from their classroom door.

When pupils are dismissed from the playground can parents please ensure that they don't block their passage and can we ask you to keep the court yard free?

## Outside play equipment

Please can we inform parents that outdoor play equipment should only be used by pupils when members of school staff or after school club staff are supervising those areas? This applies to school hours and out of school hours.

This is to meet requirements of our health and safety policy, and to ensure that equipment has been checked before use,

conditions are suitable for use, appropriate clothing is worn and supervision levels are appropriate.

**This applies especially in our Reception base.**

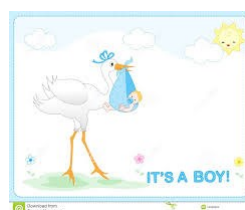


## New Teaching Staff

## Curriculum letters

You should soon be receiving curriculum letters from your child's year group teacher. This will give you an overview of what your child will be covering over the next few weeks. It will also give you guidance on homework and year group expectations of what your child is expected to do.

## Uniform

Please ensure all children are dressed in appropriate school uniform. Our school uniform consists of: Red fleece, jumper or cardigan (in year 5 and 6 only there is an option to wear a black fleece), black or grey trousers, skirt or pinafore, white polo shirt or blouse and sensible shoes. Children will need a coat for the winter.

Children must also have a PE kit which is shorts, t-shirt, jogging bottoms and trainers. Children will do PE inside and outdoors.

We like children to take pride in their appearance and expect that uniform will be worn at all times unless the Head teacher is notified.

Can we please make sure that uniform is clearly labelled with the child's name? Also please ensure all other items being brought into school are clearly labelled, such as snack boxes, drinks, glass cases etc. This will give us the best chance of returning misplaced items to their owners.

## Breakfast Club

Breakfast club started last week on the 30th August. It is held between 8:10-8:40 am (door closes at 8:30 am). Pupils need to come into school by the main entrance, located next to the car park. Breakfast is 50p a day or £2:00 for the week. Pupils must produce the money in order to have breakfast.

## After School Club

After School Club starts today. Children staying for After-School Club will be taken to their club room (small hall) by an adult from the class and will be dismissed from the small hall at the back of the school.

## Walking Bus

The Walking Bus also starts from today. This is a service where pupils are met in the morning at certain bus stops and walk into school with staff and then join in with Breakfast club.
