Reception

Children will be held in the playground by a member of staff until 3.15pm. This will allow for parents movement around the site.

After this time children will be taken to the school office and a phone call will be made home. If parents are uncontactable after 3.20pm and no message has been left at the office emergency contact numbers will be used. If this is unsuccessful the Leicester City Council safeguarding procedures will be used and social services will be informed.
